ITEM TITLE: Discuss Converting Tradewinds Park from a Passive Park to a Dog Park

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Directors discuss converting Tradewinds Park from a passive park to a dog park.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

Converting the park will require initial costs to accommodate a dog park (e.g. fencing, water station, gated entrance, seating, shade) and may impact routine maintenance as result of higher use. Suggested dog turf replacement to lower maintenance and elimination of water fees but higher cost factor for purchase and installation.

BACKGROUND:

Tradewinds Park was constructed as a passive park and was part of the County’s park inventory until the County transferred park ownership to the District as part of a settlement agreement. The park sits next to open space and primarily serves those living within a quarter mile radius. Serving as a passive park there are limited amenities which include a small circular trail, picnic benches, and a small grass area.
