ITEM TITLE: Consider Authorizing the General Manager to Execute a Contract with Emergency Construction Services Inc. to Install a Fence at Ambrose Park in the Amount of \$21,700.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Directors authorize the General Manager to execute a contract with Emergency Construction Services Inc. to install a fence at Ambrose Park in the amount of \$21,700.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The project will be funded through funds received from the insurance settlement for the loss of the Ambrose Park bocce court building due to fire. The project cost includes a 10% contingency.

BACKGROUND:

The Ambrose Park bocce court building was lost as a result of fire; the loss is covered by insurance. All that remains from the demolition of the building is a retaining wall that doubled as a wall for the structure. The wall was constructed using concrete masonry units (CMU) and appears to be in good condition. However, due to the age of the wall and the potential for vandalism (e.g., graffiti) it is recommended to construct a fence directly in front of the retaining wall. This would serve two purposes; one, provide a safety barrier should the retaining wall fail and two, serve as a deterrent to vandalism.
