5. General Manager's Report:

The General Manager and Recreation Coordinator provided brief reports on the following topics:

- 1. Weather Delays weather has pushed back projects but now moving along; we anticipate more activity this year at parks
- 2. Lynbrook Park ribbon cutting on Saturday, April 15 at 10am; will have basketball courts resurfaced within the next 3 weeks

At this moment, Director Garcia joined the meeting.

- 3. Ambrose Park irrigation has started; hydroseeding starts next week
- 4. Alves Lane Mini Park irrigation pump should be completed shortly; waiting for permit from PG&E to move on with electrical; also doing fence repairs
- 5. Recreation Programs & Services –flag football tryouts will be on April 19th and 22nd with practices on Monday and Wednesday evenings; dance classes are full; scheduling another 8-week dance program for summer; will be offering yoga and youth yoga on Wednesdays starting this summer; Shorinji Kempo is now completely back at the community center; Contra Costa County is doing a presentation on legal services for seniors on April 24th at 11:45am
- 6. Anuta Park waiting for final dates for delivery and installation for playground

a. Consider Authorizing the General Manager to Execute a Contract with Emergency Construction Services Inc. to Install a Fence at Ambrose Park in the Amount of \$21,700. Mr. Long explained that the fence would be installed to serve as a barrier for the retaining wall that was left after the Bocce Building fire. Phase II of the project would be to figure out what to do with the building footprint. Mr. Long proposed to put a second rental area, similar to the Lion's Den, to create some revenue. Board can consider at a later date.
