ITEM TITLE: Consider Authorizing the General Manager to Execute a Right of Entry and Encroachment Agreement with Little Sprouts Garden Academy

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board of Directors authorize the General Manager to Execute a Right of Entry and Encroachment Agreement with Little Sprouts Garden Academy (attachment 1).

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The \$50,000 Lowe's 100 Hometowns grant will be used to support capital improvements and programming at the Glo Magleby Community Garden. No matching funds are required. The terms are set forward in the Lowe's 100 Hometowns Grant Program Agreement (attachment 1), administered by Points of Light.

BACKGROUND:

Jasmine Cisneros, on behalf of District, applied for grant funds provided by the Lowe's 100 Hometowns Grant Program ("Grant Program"), administered by the Points of Light Foundation, for community improvement projects in the amount of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) to construct various improvements at the Community Garden. Ms. Cisneros details the scope of work the grant will cover in "attachment 2".

Ambrose Community Garden is one of the 100 impact projects that are the cornerstone of 100 Hometowns, an initiative to celebrate Lowe's centennial. Lowe's received more than 2,200 submissions to the 100 Hometowns program, which invited people across the country to nominate their hometown projects in need.
